From its founding in South Zuzuarregui, God empowered this church to grow and experience many blessings even beyond its members' expectations. Despite a major setback due to a fire that destroyed the church back in 2015, God rebuilt a better and bigger church on that same location in Zuzuarregui. Eleven years later, it has been revealed that the Lord has even bigger plans for FOCIM Quezon City in line

with its mandate to relocate, build, and expand. **FOCIM Quezon City has found a new home in San Antonio Place, Capitol Hills Drive.** God gave FOCIM Quezon City a new location with great potential for expansion by bringing more people to Jesus Christ as it is in the middle of several villages and residential developments such as Ayala Heights, Capitol Hills, M Residences, Filinvest and Loyola Grand Villas just to name a few.



Declarations on the New Sanctuary

Last April 4 2026, FOCIM Quezon City dedicated its new sanctuary to the Lord. Leaders from both the mother church (FOCIM Mandaluyong) and FOCIM Quezon City made their respective declarations such that the place will be welcome to all people open to knowing Christ. Welcome Home FOCIM Quezon City!

In his exhortation, Pastor Daniel Guinigundo welcomed FOCIM Quezon City in its new home. He shared that it was him and his wife, Sis. Kat Guinigundo, who were led by the Lord towards FOCIM Quezon City's new sanctuary.

As they frequent San Antonio Place, they discovered a spacious air-conditioned room at the third floor and God impressed upon them the potential of the said room for FOCIM Quezon City. The couple found the place on December 27, 2025. By January 13, 2026, they started praying for the place. During the inquiries and negotiations, the Lord granted FOCIM Quezon City favor after favor. **In just under three months, God established FOCIM Quezon City's new church at the third floor of San Antonio Place in Capitol Hills.**



Brother Daniel further explained that FOCIM Quezon City's relocation to San Antonio Place can be likened to the **Israelites journey to the promised land** of Canaan, the land of milk and honey, told in the book of Joshua.

Given that FOCIM Quezon City was able to relocate to a bigger place with much potential, the work is not yet done. The promise is not the same as the possession. **The church must possess the land.** Possessing the land entails responsibility. FOCIM Quezon City needs to have intimacy with the Lord (Joshua 1:7-9) in order to achieve victory. Lastly, **FOCIM Quezon City is called to transform** San Antonio Place into the kingdom of God. This is an essential step towards transforming Quezon City and eventually our nation.





God's Desire for FOCIM Quezon city

FOCIM Senior Pastor Rev. Diwa Guinigundo shared three points that God wants for FOCIM Quezon City:

1.) **FOCIM Quezon City should be the Menorah** (The Lampstand) geared towards teaching the Word of God. It should serve as a Lampstand to the city and the nation by proclaiming the truth of the Gospel.

2.) **Whoever comes to FOCIM Quezon City will receive healing and restoration.** Not just healthwise but also spiritual, financial, and even broken relationships.

3.) **FOCIM Quezon City should be modeled after the heart of God.** It should be able to raise funds to provide scholarships for children lacking financial means but having good potential. It should also be seen as a fathering church to its community by looking after both its spiritual and physical welfare.

Bro. Diwa then prayed to cleanse the place from any negative or unnecessary spirit. He asked the FOCIM Ministry Team members to pray and ask for double portion of anointing on each and every leader of FOCIM Quezon City as anointing destroys the yoke of the enemy.
